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Objectives

The course will introduce to the basic concepts to understand the Social and Solidarity Economy, and to some clue aspects for setting up an enterprise with these principles. Some experiences from the Social and Solidarity Economy will be invited.

Structure

The course has 4, 2.5-hours classes. The different sessions will involve a mixing of teaching, discussion, personal and group work. There will be inspiring visits to/ from experiences on Social and Solidarity Economy.

Evaluation

There will be an assignment reporting a project idea developed during the sessions. It will be a group work. If someone is working on a project idea that is developed with a group that is not part of the master, the report can be handed in individually. Guidelines for the evaluation will be available at the beginning of the module.
